

Ladder & Step Ladder Awareness Training Course

The aim of the course is to provide participants with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to use ladders and step ladders safely in the workplace

- ✓ Have an awareness of the requirements for Roof Work / Fragile surfaces and Edge Protection
- ✓ Know the control measures required to control the risks associated with the use of Ladders and Step Ladders.
